

Need help feeding your kids when school is out for the summer?

Learn how Ohio's Summer EBT/SUN Bucks program can help you!

How does it work?

Summer EBT, also called SUN Bucks, is an Ohio program that helps families buy food for school-aged children during the summer. Eligible families receive \$120 per child to purchase groceries, and children can still participate in other summer meal programs. Benefits are loaded onto a Summer EBT card mailed to your home or added to your existing Ohio Direction Card. The card can be used at grocery stores, farmers markets, and other locations that accept SNAP EBT to buy approved foods such as fruits, vegetables, meat, whole grains, and dairy.

Is my child eligible?

Your child is eligible for Ohio Summer EBT/SUN Bucks if:

- Your household already participates in SNAP
 - Your child's benefits will be automatically added to their Ohio Direction card and do NOT need to apply. If you participated last year in SEBT, your benefits will be reloaded on that same card, and you don't need a new one.
- Your child attends a school that offers the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) or School Breakfast Program (SBP), and your student has a free or reduced-price lunch application filed.
- Your child participates in Medicaid or OWF and your household income is at or below 185% of the FPL, they'll be automatically enrolled but will receive a new card in the mail.

How do I enroll my child in Summer EBT/SUN Bucks?

Many families will get Summer EBT/SUN Bucks automatically if they are getting other benefits, but some families may need to apply for the program.

If your household receives SNAP, OWF and/or is Medicaid income eligible for free and reduced price meals or has been directly certified for reduced price meals, they will be automatically enrolled in the Summer EBT/SUN Bucks program. You do not need to fill out an application. You will get a card in the mail, or the benefits will be added to your Ohio Direction Card.

If you are not automatically enrolled and believe your child(ren) are eligible, you can apply for Summer EBT/SUN Bucks by filling out a simple application using the QR code below.








If your child does not receive SNAP, OWF, is not Medicaid income eligible and has not been directly approved for free/reduced price school meals, you may still be eligible based on your household income. If your household income falls at or below these monthly guidelines, you should complete the Ohio Summer EBT application.
